## Meet Manager: Caroline Stedman


### Teams: 2012 Red Girls



## **DONOVAN RIPS USMNT: 'Talent is great, pride is better'**

U.S. men's national team legend Landon Donovan ripped the team's underwhelming performance at the Concacaf Nations League on Monday.

U.S. men's national team legend Landon Donovan ripped the team's underwhelming performance at the Concacaf Nations League on Monday.

Landon Donovan could not believe what he saw at the Concacaf Nations League from the USMNT. U.S. men's national team legend Landon Donovan ripped the team's underwhelming performance at the Concacaf Nations League on Monday. He didn't mince his words.

"I'm so sick of hearing how 'talented' this group of players is and all the amazing clubs they play for," he said on X (formerly Twitter). "If you aren't going to show up and actually give a s!%\* about playing for your national team, decline the invite. Talent is great, pride is better."

Donovan's comments came after the Americans lost both their matches at the CNL final four. They lost to Panama, 1-0, in the semifinals on Thursday and then to Canada in the third-place match.

The U.S. entered the final four as three-time defending champion, never having lost a semifinal or final match. Donovan knows something about playing with pride for his country. He scored 57 goals in 157 appearances for the USMNT. At the club level, Donovan was a member of a record six MLS Cup-winning teams. He also is the league's all-time assists leader with 136. The Major League Soccer MVP Award was renamed in his honor.

***So the next time your coach tells you that talent isn't enough and that hard working players are preferred over talented ones, just remember this is something that is true even at the highest level of soccer!***
